The children created beautiful clay pots as gifts for Mothering Sunday. They carefully planted sunflower seeds in their pots, using all the knowledge they have gained about how plants grow. We have now begun our RVE learning for the Spring term, focusing on Light. The children have loved exploring this theme, especially when a very exciting Photo Booth appeared in our classroom! With party hats, glow sticks and lots of sparkly, reflective objects, the children explored how we all shine our light like Jesus in our own unique and special ways.



We began the month by creating beautiful Mothering Sunday poems for our mums. The children worked so hard to write thoughtful and loving messages, and we made them extra special by recording our voices and turning them into QR codes to include in our cards – such a lovely keepsake!

We also read "Dragon Post" by Emma Yarlett, which the children absolutely loved. Inspired by the story, we explored letter writing and took on the role of the dragon, writing our own replies to Alex.

In Maths, Reception children have been exploring length. They had lots of fun measuring their feet and comparing sizes with their friends, using key vocabulary such as shorter and longer. They also compared objects around the classroom, developing their understanding through practical activities.

Year 1 have been busy learning to measure using rulers and recording lengths in centimetres. They have shown great focus and care when measuring classroom objects. We are also really impressed with their growing confidence in recalling their 2, 5 and 10 times tables.
