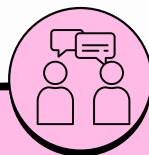


PROVISION AT WICK

An Emotional Literacy Support Assistant helps children with their emotional development within school. Children may receive individual or group sessions targeted on developing a range of strategies. These strategies help both emotional regulation and help with the development of social skills.



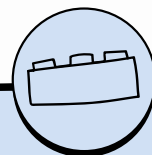
WELLCOMM

This programme is used to identify areas of concern in language, communication, and interaction in order to ensure early targeted intervention.



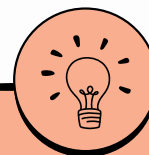
FLOURISH

An eight week project designed to help improve learners mental and emotional well-being and increase levels of self-esteem, resilience and general happiness.



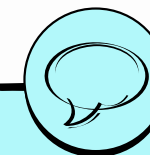
LEGO THERAPY
