What a busy five weeks it has been! To celebrate the end of our Expressive Arts inquiry, we shared our learning with parents, guardians and grandparents. We performed a range of songs and impressed our audience with our fantastic pBuzz playing. We even wrote our own script, showing creativity and confidence. Everyone had so much fun! We especially loved our week with Lisa from iSingPOP, which built up to an exciting whole-school performance at St Illtyd's Church. It was a wonderful opportunity to perform together and showcase our talents.



In our RVE inquiry we have been learning about light and darkness in Hinduism, exploring how light symbolises goodness, hope and the triumph of good over evil. We looked at the story of Rama and Sita and the festival of Diwali. We have also been learning about Holy Week through creative activities. We wrote kennings based on Jesus in the Garden of Gethsemane, exploring his thoughts and feelings. We created cross silhouette artwork, using light and dark to show emotion and meaning. We also reflected on Holy Week and looked at each event and whether they represented light or darkness.

In Numeracy, we have been learning all about time. We started by telling the time using a.m. and p.m., reading analogue and digital clocks, and telling the time to the nearest minute using both the hour and minute hands. We then explored the 24-hour clock. Finally, we measured and compared time in seconds, minutes and hours, and solved problems by finding start and end times.
