The children have been loving their Forest School sessions, especially growing and cooking their own vegetables—master chefs in the making! In maths, we've moved on to multiplication and division, and the class has tackled these new skills with determination.

In literacy, the children have explored the lives of Earth Heroes — such as David Attenborough and Ellen McArthur — and written autobiographies from their perspectives, showing impressive empathy and creativity. They've also recently completed powerful wartime letters, writing as soldiers reaching out to their families from the front line. These will be shared as part of our poignant Remembrance service after half term.
