In Teilo we have had such a lovely start to the year! We have been inspired by Dai Woolridge's 'God's Brilliantly Big Creation Story: water colour plants, Hama beads sea and sky, and threading animals are just a few of the activities we have enjoyed doing. We have also been learning more about school values including perseverance trust, friendship and fairness.



In Numeracy, our focus has been on place value, addition and subtraction. We have also been using Winning With Numbers which is excellent - we can use this at home too! In Literacy we have explored two books - Belonging and The King who banned the dark. We retold belonging putting the beautiful pictures into our own words.

Our Inquiry this term is 'Let there be Light'. First, we immersed ourselves into a light sensory room, we experimented with light reflections and created our own 'stained glass' windows. We have been carrying out science investigations with e-sgol where we have fired rockets using alka-seltzer and water and measuring craters from asteroids in the moon (dropping different balls in flour).
